FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC GREATER ROUND LAKE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

The Board of Fire Commissioners for the Greater Round Lake FPD will conduct examinations for qualified persons to establish an eligibility list from which firefighter/paramedic vacancies will be filled. Candidates must meet the following minimum requirements:

At least 18 years of age but less than 35 years of age or have previous employment status as a fireman in a regularly constituted fire department of any fire protection district; US citizen; high school graduate or GED equivalent; Illinois State Certified Firefighter II; Illinois Licensed Paramedic or current paramedic student; posses a valid driver's license which must be shown as identification at all phases of testing and possess a CPAT card that has been issued within six months of the application deadline.

Applicants must be of good moral character and meet all requirements of the Board of Fire Commissioners and the State of Illinois. Applicants must successfully complete all phases of testing to be placed upon the eligibility list. Placement upon the eligibility list does not guarantee future employment with the Greater Round Lake FPD.

Applications may be picked up in person at the Greater Round Lake FPD Station 1 Administrative Offices; 409 W. Nippersink Road; Round Lake, Illinois (847-546-6001), Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Completed applications must be returned to the Business Office no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, August 13, 2010.

The following schedule has been established for the required examinations: Orientation – 7:00 p.m. 08/23/10; Written Exam – 9:00 a.m. 08/28/10; Oral Interviews – as scheduled.
